We are gearing up for a great day of competition and a wonderful celebration of our school spirit. We have many exciting events planned to make this a fantastic day for the whole family to enjoy together. We can't wait to see you there!

Schedule of Events

Field Day – 8:30 a.m. at Old Kempner Stadium. Students will be dropped off at school at the regular time of 7:40 a.m. The students will parade to Kempner Stadium and we will begin Opening Ceremonies at 8:30 a.m. Parents are encouraged to drop off their student(s) and head to the stadium to grab a good seat! Each class will compete in various races and then break into smaller teams to participate in field events. Students will be dismissed at the end of Field Day at 11:30 a.m. Pre-K through 3rd grade will be dismissed from the back of the Community Center and 4th grade through 8th grade will be dismissed from the back of the Gym. There will be a sign-out sheet for dismissal.

Family Festival – 12:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. Following the Field Day events, all students, families and friends are invited to our Spring Family Festival held on the school grounds. We will have rides, games, and tons of food! We are selling wristbands for each person wishing to have access to unlimited rides and games. Food sales and individual ride and game tickets are also available for purchase. In addition, don't miss your chance to win one of our fantastic raffle prizes. The winning tickets will be awarded at the end of the evening during the Pasta Dinner.

The Family Festival will continue with a **Pasta Dinner and Auction beginning at 4:30 p.m.** in the Community Center. The Pasta Dinner will be a buffet dinner and will be available from 4:30 p.m. until 7:30 p.m. Our Auction will feature student artwork and handmade items in addition to many wonderful donations from our sponsors and underwriters.

F.A.Q.s:

What does my child wear?

All students should wear their Field Day t-shirt (provided with the purchase of a wristband) or plain white shirt and gym shorts. Please keep in mind there will be water events at Field Day!

How do I get a Field Day t-shirt?

You will receive a field day t-shirt with each purchase of a festival wristband. Please remember to mark your child's t-shirt size on the attached order form.

Who can come to Field Day and the Spring Family Festival?

We want to encourage parents, grandparents and all family and friends to attend the events!

What goes on during the field events?

Each class will be divided into 2 groups, either the Blue or Gold team. After the Opening Ceremonies, the competitions begin. The students will compete as a class, the Gold team versus the Blue team in racing events. Once all classes have completed their event, the students will be further divided into teams consisting of a 7th grade team captain with teammates from Pre-K to grade 6. The teams will rotate between competitions on the field. At the completion of all events, awards will be given to the winning teams. Please don't miss the passing of the torch event at the end of the competition! Get your cameras ready to capture some great moments.

What goes on at the Family Festival?

After the conclusion of the field events and student dismissal, the Family Festival will open. We will have carnival games and rides for all ages. And get ready to eat! We will have pizza, popcorn, cotton candy, pretzels, drinks, and more. Don't forget to visit the Family Information Booth and the Cake/Cookie Walk!

The **Field Day Raffle** is a great end to a great day. You can purchase raffle tickets prior to and during the Family Festival. The raffle prizes are amazing and you will want to be a part of it! Raffle tickets can be purchased with the attached form and will be available up to and including the day of the event. The ticket cost is \$1 per ticket or \$18 for a book of 20 tickets.

Where do I park?

Parking will be available in the lot behind the Community Center and the City of Sugar Land lot. The School and Church office parking lot will be closed after morning drop off in order to set up the festival rides and game booths.

What do Tickets and Wristbands cover? How much do they cost?

Wristbands are \$25 and cover all the rides and games. Tickets may be purchased for \$.50 each and are used for the rides and games. Food is cash only. Please see order form below for your wristband purchase. Tickets will be sold on the day of the event only.

How do I get tickets for the Pasta Dinner? How much do they cost?

The Pasta dinner is \$20 for adults and \$10 for children 12 and under. Tickets can be purchased on the attached form and up to and including the day of the event.
