Summer Camps

Saint Theresa Conservatory Choral Music Intensive

- Designed for:** Students entering 3rd grade and up (Sopranos)
Instructors: Zachary Turner, John Robinson, Lauren Henderson-Turner
Dates: June 11 through June 15, 2018
Times: Monday through Thursday – 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.
Friday – 8:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.
Students should bring a sack lunch each day. Dinner will be provided on Friday evening before the performance.
Cost: \$450

Description: The Choral Music Intensive will provide specialized instruction in a choral setting and strive to develop knowledge and skills in Music History, Music Theory, and Composition/Improvisation. Two 20-minute individual lessons in voice will be conducted by Lauren Henderson-Turner and are offered to each participant. These lessons will focus on posture, breathing, phonation, and diction in an effective and personalized way that is impossible to achieve in the choral setting. Students will each work on a song appropriate to his or her individual musical aptitude. Students will have the opportunity to perform for the group in the Friday performance. The program is designed for sopranos (boys and girls) entering 3rd grade and up. Mr. John Robinson, the renowned Director of Music for St. Paul's Church and Master of the Chorister for St. Paul's Choir School, Harvard Square, will direct rehearsals and sessions and conduct the performance Friday evening. The Intensive will conclude with a performance on Friday evening at 6:30 p.m.

NOTE: Because of the intensive nature of this program, an audition by the applicant, or prior knowledge of the applicant's musical aptitude is required. The music intensive is limited to the first 20 applicants who demonstrate the requisite musical abilities.

Ample time will be given for flexibility exercises as well as for fun and creative activities with props. Pink ballet slippers are required. Crafting Creations

Description: Creative crafts provide hands-on fun for children of all ages. We will complete 2 – 3 projects each week using canvas, paint, floral and clay. Students will develop both their fine motor skills and their creativity over the course of the sessions.

Art Discovery

Description: Enable your child to discover the artist within! Students will paint their personal masterpiece, make their own mold, and create their own sculpture. The program aims to give each child a sense of technique, Art History, and personal creative development during the individual sessions.

Coding Camp

Designed for: Students entering 5th through 8th grade.

Description: Computer Science Fundamentals Express is a 30+ hour Code.org course for students age 9 and up, designed by K-12 and university teachers. The curriculum offers excellent on-line support from the likes of Google, Microsoft, and Facebook. Students use a visual programming language (drag-and-drop, block-based, rather than typing code) and learn to create computer programs that will help them learn to collaborate with others, develop problem-solving skills, and persist through difficult tasks. They will study programming concepts, computational thinking, digital citizenship, and develop interactive games or stories they can share. Students will receive their own computer hardware needed during the course and is included in the cost of the camp.

Cricket Camp

Cost: \$200/week

Description: Students will be introduced to the basic skills in, history of, and current leading figures in the game of Cricket. Development of bowling and batting techniques helps to develop large and fine motor skills and the game promotes collaborative play and socialization, while providing important cultural clues to this game associated with the member nations of the former British Empire. Individual and group instruction will be provided to students during the course of the sessions.

Individual and group instruction will be included during the course of the sessions.

Description: Our Academic Program reviews grade-level content such as grammar, writing, poetry, geography, Baltimore Catechism, Latin, and Spanish for students new to STCS in the upcoming school year. This class makes for a much more smooth transition into the school in the fall. In addition:

- Students are able to acquaint themselves with their new learning environment and become comfortable with their new school and surroundings.
- Students are able to meet and make friends with others new to the school.
- Students are able to meet and get to know some of the teachers they will be seeing on a daily basis in the fall.
- Students are able to gain confidence in their ability to acclimate into the classical curriculum at Saint Theresa. Each student who enrolls into our school comes from a previous learning environment that is unique and different from their peers. This program will help them to “hit the ground running” on the first day of school.

Description: Miss McKinley's summer tutoring program will be a personalized program designed to fit the needs of each child enrolled. For example, some readers will need to work on decoding and fluency skills, while others will need strategies to help increase reading comprehension. Math students may need number sense and computation practice, or they may need to work with word problems using Singapore Math strategies. Writing and language lessons are also available. Each student enrolled in this program will be evaluated through parent communication, past teacher recommendations, and ongoing daily interaction with the instructor.
