Welcome to First Grade!

Incoming First Graders should continue to read throughout the summer. Please list all the books that your child reads over next two months. A reading log is attached. This is due the first day of school, and it will count for a reading grade.

Students must read the following stories and choose one to reflect upon. A reflection sheet is attached. These stories can be read in paper or digital format.

- *The Boy Who Cried Wolf*
- *Jack and the Beanstalk*
- *Three Billy Goats Gruff*
- *The Little Engine That Could*
- *Henny Penny*

The three stages of reading practice are below. These three ways of reading may be used at any time.

1. Read To- books are read to the student.
2. Read With- shared reading with an adult (i.e. the adult reads a page, then the student reads a page).
3. Read independently- the student reads on his/her own by choosing appropriate reading level books.

Make reading experiences loving and enjoyable. Even independent readers enjoy being read to occasionally.
